Formed in 1977, we are a charity dedicated to supporting everyone involved in childcare and early years to provide high quality services, information and advice to children, their families and carers. We want all children to experience high quality childcare and early education, helping them to have a bright future.

We are a community of nearly 14,000 Early Years Providers.

We represent 50% of registered Childminders in England and Wales.

Our members are childminders, nannies, childminding assistants, nursery workers, nursery managers and local authorities.

Our policy work

PACEY represents its members to policy makers at all levels of government, working to ensure that members' needs and views are taken into account and ensure children get the best start in life.

From campaigning on ratios and regulations, to responding to government consultations, PACEY works with national and local government in England and Wales to help shape and influence early years policy.

We're also commissioned by local and national government to provide services to early years professionals, including training for childminders and promoting childcare as a profession. And we offer a specific package of support to local childcare providers through local authorities.

Our key policy asks

A universal, national funded programme of childminder preregistration support.

Accessible post registration support to enable professional growth of childminders and mechanisms to reduce isolation and provide emotional support.

Funding systems and payments that are fair and sustainable.

A clear, consistent approach to reducing barriers and enabling childminders to deliver funded high-quality childcare and early education in Wales.

Reform of the current rule that excludes non-parental relatives from providing funded childcare to related children in England.

An obligation on all local authorities to audit existing wraparound provision in their area and avoid undermining childminder provision. Improvements to the Universal Credit system to allow for the unique working context of childminders.

A joined-up, national approach to define and clarify local planning, commercial waste and environmental health requirements for childminders to reduce the burden felt by childminders.

A long term strategy for early education and childcare that understands the unique value of childminders and puts them at the centre of addressing the unequal access that is currently leaving disadvantaged children, including those with SEND and ALN, missing out.

70 PERCENT


Nearly 70% of our members provide wraparound care, allowing parents the flexibility to work.

How we support childminders

Pre registration

- Working with government and local authorities on strategies to recruit new childminders to the workforce.
- Careers advice and career pathway support via our library of resources on our website.
- PACEY's pre-registration trainingour Level 3 Award in Preparing to Work in Home-based Childcare (HBCA) is the most comprehensive qualification to help you cover everything you need to begin a career in homebased childcare as a childminder or nanny in England.
- We have built an online community to support those joining the profession. Our Facebook group 'First steps to childminding' has 4.4k members.

Post registration

- PACEY members get FREE bitesized online training on topics including SEND, transitions, physical development, maths, creative arts and many more. There are over 75 courses for England members.
- PACEY hosts both in person events and online webinars for both members and nonmembers. Our events are aimed at getting early years providers together to support each other.
- We have hundreds of business and practice resourcesinformation, advice and guidance that we share with members and non-members.
- We work tirelessly with government to improve working conditions for childminders to retain a skilled and passionate workforce.
